MINUTES SOCIAL/CLIMATE ACTION NETWORK (SCAN) December 6, 2025

Those attending: Jolie Will, George Will, TV Reed, Noel Sturgeon, Pam Hicks, Emily Beals, Kathy Jenkins, Mike Chains. Guest: Heather Vickery.

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 with a welcome to Heather, UUSC Co-ordinator for Congregational Activism with current focus on immigrant and trans/gay issues, including Pink Haven. Heather has deep experience working with congregations who want to increase their involvement with the urgent social/climate justice issues facing us today.

Some of her recommendations for a congregation of our size:

- 1) narrow our focus and choose interconnected areas when feasible. Be 'weavers' meaning, weave issues together, Given the size of our congregation and our SCAN group, focus on 1 or 2 projects rather than 3 or 4.
- 2) each focus group needs to have 3-5 involved participants to maintain sustainability.
- 3) know what the needs are in your community, seek partners, build relationships, do your research.
- 4) Be 'disrupters' but choose your focus carefully. Not everyone needs to be a disrupter. Be careful what you put on the internet. Discuss and assess the level of risk we are willing to take.
- 5) Be visionaries. Look ahead at where you want to go, and plan on how to get there.
- 6) Become familiar with the work of Emery Bounds on social justice activism as well as the UU Workbook, <u>Change Now</u>, by Deepa Ayur

Suggestions for the way forward:

- 1) Educate yourself on your community and the issues. Forums are a good 1st step.
- 2) Service: roll up your sleeves, choose your action and make it happen.
- 3) Create political connections, become advocacy partners and assist others in their work.
- 4) Become public 'witnesses' and make your presence and values known in the larger community.
- 5) Explore what it means to be an 'accompanyment.'
- 6) Take steps toward 'civil disobedience' when that seems like the next most needed step.

- 7) Link SCAN to the OUUF Website and be sure to keep information on it updated.
- 8) Make a presentation to the Board as to what you want to do via the website and your action plans.
